## ROBERT STEWART PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBIT

Councilmember Garcetti's field office in Silver Lake will host an exhibit of the work of Los Angeles photographer Robert Stewart. The show will commence with an opening reception on Friday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 6:30 pm to 9 pm.

Stewart's photographs capture the transformations undergone by the skyscrapers and streets of downtown Los Angeles as they shift from the glare of afternoon sunlight to the shrouding glow of nighttime street lamps. Series of up to half a dozen pictures shot of the same scene from the same location reveal a protean metropolis. Downtown's office towers turn from impermeable, reflective corporate vessels to dark towers, joining the night sky, and Echo Park street corners surrender their grit for a soft glow, all in the space of an hour's setting sun.

Stewart has lived in the 13<sup>th</sup> Council District since 1966. He holds a BFA in Painting from the University of New Mexico, and has undertaken graduate studies at Los Angeles Trade and Technical College and Los Angeles City College. He is a member of the California Society of Printmakers and is represented by Orlando Gallery in Tarzana and by Modern Art Downtown.
